



Control by the Hemispheres (sides) of the Brain	
Note: The hemispheres also work together and cannot be neatly divided.	
RIGHT Side	LEFT Side

**Reaction Time:** Simple reaction time is the interval between the onset of the stimulus and the response under the condition that the subject has been instructed to respond as rapidly as possible.
