

Scientific Drawing Rules:

- ___ 1. Use **pencil** and **plain paper**. Label with your name and its name.
- ___ 2. Use **solid lines**; do not sketch.
- ___ 3. Draw **part for part** as you observe and identify.
Do NOT draw from memory.
Three parts mean 3 drawings.
- ___ 4. Draw as **large** as your paper allows.
- ___ 5. **Do not shade**. Stipple (tiny tapping dots) if time.
- ___ 6. Label parts with **straight lines** out to one side.
Line has to **touch** what it labels with **no arrow**.
- ___ 7. Include Title and size or magnification. (___X)
- ___ 8. **Have checked while you have the object (in focus if in microscope).**
