## Scientific Drawing Rules:

1. Use <b>pencil</b> and <b>plain paper</b> . Label with your name and its name.
2. Use <b>solid lines</b> ; do not sketch.
3. Draw <b>part for part</b> as you observe and identify.  Do NOT draw from memory.  Three parts mean 3 drawings.
4. Draw as large as your paper allows.
5. <b>Do not shade</b> . Stipple (tiny tapping dots) if time.
6. Label parts with <b>straight lines</b> out to one side. Line has to <b>touch</b> what it labels with <b>no arrow</b> .
7. Include Title and size or magnification. (X)
8. Have checked while you have the object (in focus if in microscope).
